

The Lord has brought together the **generosity** of hundreds of faithful supporters, friends, churches and organizations to bring WCM to the construction goal of \$8.2 million dollars.

From individual gifts of all varieties, donations of property and securities, grants and tax credits from private and public sources, WCM was able to begin construction to take advantage of the lower costs available today. This is taken as a step of continued, faithful stewardship by WCM.

To begin in this timely way WCM also utilized savings and reserves that are held to ensure the ministry will continue to operate without deficits or borrowing to meet day-to-day needs. During the construction of the new building these funds are committed to maintain the progress of the project. This means WCM needs to replenish these funds. Our goal is \$1.1 million dollars in the coming year.

STEWARDSHIP SUMMARY

Generosity

With gratitude for your **generosity**, WCM has received \$4.5M in gifts from friends of the ministry.

The **Generosity** and **Stewardship** Goal of \$1.1M will complete all funding needs for a debt-free completion to the new building project.

Stewardship

Because of WCM's history of good **stewardship** and fiscal responsibility, WCM has received \$2.1M in funding from New Markets Tax Credits through USBank.

Recognized as vital to the community, WCM has received a grant of \$500K from the Dunham Fund of Aurora.

Utilizing \$800K long-term reserve **stewardship** funds, WCM was able to break ground now to take advantage of savings in the cost of building and construction.

Replenishing WCM **stewardship** funds and reducing the additional line-of-credit will bring WCM to a debt-free completion of the new building project.
